Large Cap Stocks	Stocks of U.S. companies that have a market capitalization of \$4.0 billion or more.	
Small Cap Stocks	Stocks of U.S. companies that have a market capitalization of under \$4.0 billion.	
International Stocks	Publicly traded stocks of companies based in countries other than the U.S.	
Domestic Bonds	Government or corporate bonds issued in the U.S.	
Cash & Money Market	Stable, short-term investments that provide income that rises and falls with short-term interest rates.	
Other	Investments that cannot be classified as any of the above.
